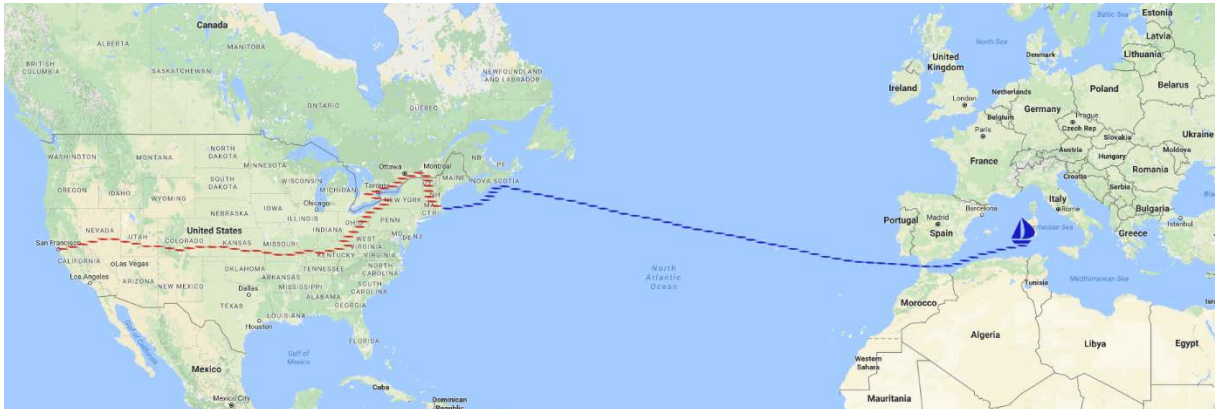


Volunteer crew from America to Europe
